- Our numbers are growing and projections are strong with skaters going from L2S to contract. Proposed opening 3 full time positions. We have a new sub, Hannah

- Locker Room Policy- A motion was made to M. O'Byrne to approve the updated locker room policy, D. Cooper seconded the motion. All in favor.

- 1. Create a changing area for all skaters to eliminate privacy/SafeSport concerns of cell phone and photography in locker rooms as well as create a gender-neutral locker room. Under the proposed layout the boys would share the locker room area and all skaters would have access to a changing room.
- 2. Create a safe gathering area where skaters can study, eat and hangout behind a secure keyed access door.
 - 3. Increase the size of the coaches' space.
