

## Rochester Figure Skating Club Annual Membership Meeting Minutes

## **Executive Reports:**

- 1. Presidents Report
  - The current RFSC Board members were introduced and recognized.
  - Program Highlights:
    - o Transition to L2S USA curriculum
    - RFSC began an Adaptive L2S program
    - o The winter sessions were the busiest ever with approximately 300 skaters
    - The club has 3 synchro teams
    - There are 22 skaters on TOI. In June 2016, they placed 4th at Nationals in Alabama
    - Upper Great Lakes Regionals was hosted by RFSC. There were 758 skaters in attendance from 8 states
    - Hiawathaland had 211 individual skaters attend
    - Ice Show had 100 contract skaters, 135 L2S skaters, with special guests Blake and Eliana

## 2. Treasurer Report

- Current year to date profit is \$82,000 including profits from UGL. UGL brought in \$67,000 in profit alone. L2S had a decline in profit due to increased expenses. The club is currently in good financial standing.
- Motion to approve the report was made by Andy Schram, seconded by Lori Jean Engle.
